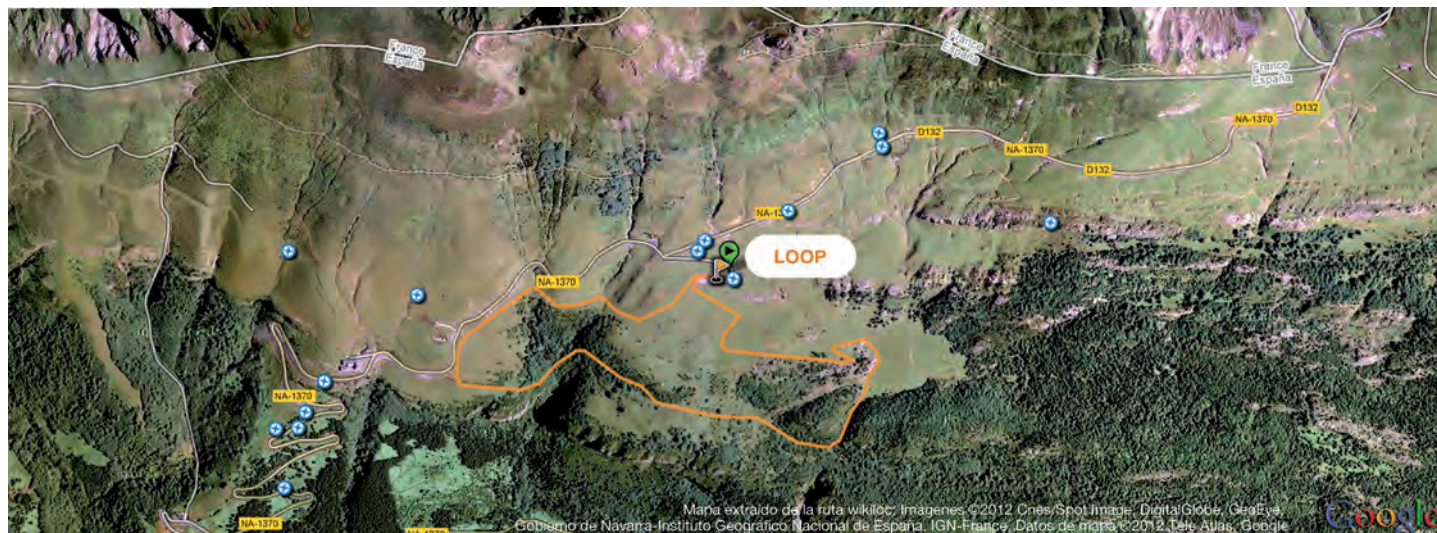


VULTOURIS ROUTES: Zemeto (Navarra)

DIFFICULTY:
MODERATE



From the parking area, descend to the flat stretch known as the llano de Eskilzarra. Continue up to the paso de Zemeto, a short rise, and veer right down the marked path. The route proceeds along the mountainside, passing an optional turnoff for a small lookout from where one can take in the Belagua Valley. Back on route, the path crosses a small canyon that concludes with a short climb drawing near to the highway. Ending up parallel to the highway, return along the path to the hut.

This route is one of the most interesting of the area, granted that in addition to offering impressive views of the Belagua Valley, it exhibits

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a concentration of old beech trees that stand out in their height and width. Furthermore, there is the possibility of seeing alpine fauna, most noteworthy of which being the chamois that inhabit the region.

The walk skirts along the boundaries of the Larra Nature Reserve, one of the foremost protected areas of Navarra, comprehending the Urkedi and Aztaparreta Reserves. For that reason it's recommended to follow the trail markings and to not leave the path, keeping in mind that the intention in safeguarding these areas is to protect the flora and fauna. All passers by need behave accordingly and adhere to the rules.
